

ISCYRA 2009 FOR 2010 RESOLUTIONS

#1-2009 Submitted by the North Garda Fleet
To Replace STCR 35.4 as follows:

In alteration of RRS 42:

- 1) If the average wind is above 12 knots, the race committee may permit pumping, rocking and ooching except on a beat to windward (Change of RRS42,2(a), RRS 42,2(b), 42,2 (c).

The signals will be made according to RRSP5.

- 2) Flag Romeo displayed near a mark indicates that: "After rounding the nearby mark, RRS42 applies without variation".

Flags specified under (1) and (2) above can be changed by the notice of race and/or by the sailing instructions. When displayed near a mark, the flags should if possible be on a hard board to maximise visibility and accompanied by a sound signal.

Reason: It is a well tested and more clear rule, in use in other Olympic classes like Finn and 470.

Having this rule in effect when the breeze picks up reduce our dependence from erroneous calls of umpires not always familiar with the Star class.

To Amend STCR 37.1.2. Housekeeping

NEW TEXT:

37.1.2. For Continental Championship (Silver) events an International Jury and a Race Committee shall be appointed by the Continental First Vice President with the approval of the Continental Committee.

OLD TEXT:

37.1.2. For Continental Championship (Silver) events a Jury and a Race Committee shall be appointed by the Continental First Vice President with the approval of the Continental Committee or, with the prior written approval by the C.M.C., an International Jury may be appointed in the manner prescribed in Rule 37.1.1.

Reason: To add consistency to all Silver Star events and to comply with the ISAF Grade C1 requirements.
