RULE 34.3.1. Course 0, 1, 2, 3, and 4 are described below. In Gold and Silver events course 0, 1, 3, or 4 shall be used; Course 2 may be used in Silver events if requested by the sponsoring fleet and approved by the Continental Committee. In Blue and Green events, course 0, 1, 2, 3, or 4 shall be used. No course may be shortened. In Red events and qualifications the above courses are not mandatory and may be shortened

PROPOSED TEXT:

34.3.1. Course 0, 1, 2, 3, and 4 are described below. In Gold and Silver events course 0, 1, 3, or 4 shall be used; Course 2 may be used in Silver events if requested by the sponsoring fleet and approved by the Continental Committee. In Blue and Green events, course 0, 1, 2, 3, or 4 shall be used. (Insert) Leg lengths refer to the first leg of a course and are measured from the Start line to Mark1. Mark 3 may be no more than .25nm from the Start Line. No course shall be shortened under RRS 32 (flag S). Course legs may be altered under RRS 33(b) (flag C and + or -) within the leg length limits applicable to the Format of the regatta. In Red events and qualifications the above courses are not mandatory and may be shortened.

REASON: The purpose of the ~~first insert addition~~ is to clarify the measurements of the leg lengths within a course. It is unclear if the distance from the starting line to the leeward mark in STCR 34.4.2 (.75nm) is valid in Gold or Silver events, and should be changed for consistency with this addition. The distance of .25nm was chosen here to provide some flexibility to a Race Committee, such as in the case of nearby lee shore. Normally the distance is 0.1nm.

The purpose of the second addition is to clarify what in a course may or not be altered. Race officers use RRS 33(b) frequently to set a longer first leg to allow for greater separation of the racing fleet at the first mark, then shorten the second beat to stay within time limits or target times (Format B and C) set in STCR 34.3.7. Additionally, this change allows a RC to lengthen a race set for a minimum distance on subsequent legs in an increasing breeze.
