RULE STCR 35.4 exists as follows:

35.4 If Course 0 (STCR 34.3.2), Course 1 (STCR 34.3.3) or Course 2 (STCR 34.3.4) are sailed in a World Sailing-graded event, rule 42 of the World Sailing-Racing Rules does not apply for the reaches (mark 1 to mark 2 and mark 2 to mark 3)..

SPECIFICATION _____ as follows:

PROPOSED TEXT:

35.4 The Race Committee may signal in accordance with RRS Appendix P5, if stated in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, that rocking is permitted after the starting signal, when the boat's proper course is not a beat to windward and when the windspeed equals or exceeds eight (8) **10** knots **sustained** as measured at deck level of a Race Committee boat near the windward mark(s). This changes RSS 42.2(b).

REASON:

The proposed language permits the Race Committee to allow rocking (prohibited by RRS 42.2(b)) on legs of any racecourse at all events in accordance with RRS P5. The phrase "a beat to windward" is the language used as the trigger that turns off RRS 18.1(a) (*Mark Room*) and does not specify on which leg of the course the action may be permissible (e.g. "reaches").
