NOTICE OF RACE

1. AUTHORITY

1.1 The Organizing Authority is the Lake Hopactong Yacht Club in conjunction with the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association hosted by the Lake Hopactong Star Fleet.

2. RULES

2.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RSS) and the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association Rules (STCR).

2.2 Rule 35 and STCR 34.3.7, Format B, will be changed. The time limit for the first boat to finish a race will be two (2) hours.

2.3 Rule 35 and STCR 34.6.3 will be changed. Boats not finishing within 30 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) and will be awarded 1 point more than the last boat to finish.

2.4 A boat that does not start within 10 minutes of the starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS) without a hearing.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The Regatta shall be open.

4. ENTRY FEE

4.1 The entry fee is TBD. Entry fees are due at time of entry.

1000 First Warning Signal Up to 3 races may be sailed

Sunday Sept 25 1000 First Warning Signal

Series is scheduled for 5 races with no throwouts.

Up to 2 races will be sailed Sunday.

No warning signal after 1300 on Sept 25.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the Lake Hopactong Yacht Club prior to June 4.

7. VENUE & COURSE

7.1 Racing will be conducted on Lake Hopactong.

7.2 Courses will be as described in the Sailing Instructions.
