## SAILING INSTRUCTIONS SUPPLEMENT

### 1 SCHEDULE

Friday, August 5, 2022	1500	Sunapee Open / District Championship Registration begins inside LSYC
Saturday, August 6, 2022	0830	Late Registration, Launch, breakfast
	0930	Competitor’s Meeting
Sunday, August 7, 2022	1055	First Warning, subsequent races to follow.
	0900	Competitor’s Briefing
	1025	First Warning
	1400	No Warning after this time
	After Racing	Lunch and Awards

All shoreside events will take place at Lake Sunapee Yacht Club.

Six (6) races are scheduled. Per STCR 27.4 (this corrects NoR 12.3), three (3) races must be completed to constitute a District Championship.

### 2 RACE OFFICE

The Race Office is located in the LSYC Clubhouse.

### 3 SIGNALS ASHORE

3.1. Signals made ashore shall be displayed from the LSYC flag staff.

3.2. When Flag AP is displayed ashore, 1 minute is replaced with “not less than 30 minutes” after AP is lowered. This changes Sailing Instruction S4.2 and Race Signals.

### **4 COURSES**

Courses will be in accordance with STCR 34.3, including Course 2. This changes Sailing Instruction S7.2.

### **5 MARKS**

Marks of the course shall be Orange inflatable buoys. Change marks will be yellow inflatable buoys.

The starting and finishing marks will be a Race Committee vessel at the starboard end and a Race Committee vessel or an orange inflatable buoy at the port end.

### **6 TIME LIMIT**

The time limit will be as described in STCR 34.3.7 Format C. RRS 35, A4, and A5 are changed to provide that boats not finishing within 30 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "TLE" as calculated per STCR 34.6.3 without a hearing.

### **7 OTHER CHANGES**

7.1- The finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag(s) on the race committee vessel(s) or the course side of the port end finishing buoy. This changes Race Signals – blue flag and Sailing Instruction S11.1.
