1. AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority is the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association, hosted by Star Class District 15's Cascais Fleet (CP), and Clube Naval de Cascais (CNC).

2. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association Rules (STCR), and the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) by World Sailing.

3. ELIGIBILITY

The Regatta shall be open to Life and Active Members of all Fleets as well as to Isolated Members sailing Star Class Boats with a valid Measurement Certificate (MC) and bearing a valid insurance policy with third party liability coverage in excess of 250,000.00€ or equivalent in other currency during the race period.

The District 15's **39th Open Championship and Vintage Cup - 81st Anniversary** welcomes boats under the Modern, Evolution, Classic, Wood Performance and Wood Classic Divisions.

All boats under other than the Modern Division will be grouped in a Vintage Cup.

4. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee includes boat and trailer storage, launching and hauling at Clube Naval de Cascais in Cascais during the Regatta. Entry fees are due at time of registration.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration

By e-mail, to the District's Office at starclassd15@gmail.com requesting the entry form, the waiver form and the indication of the preferred method of payment.

With the entry form and waiver duly filled in and signed, with copy of insurance policy and with proof of payment to designated event bank account up to November 30th, at 23H59m, GMT.

5.2 Schedule of Races

The Championship is scheduled for at least 5 races with no throw-outs.

5.3. The Organizing Authority retains the unappealing right to duly cancel any race due to adverse weather conditions, or fewer than 3 boats present for racing.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Race Office at Clube Naval de Cascais 24h before racing, amendments shall be posted at the Notice Board outside the Race Office.

7. VENUE & COURSE

7.1 Racing will be conducted in Cascais Bay, Cascais, Portugal.

7.2 Courses will be as described in the Sailing Instructions.

7.3 A dinner is scheduled for Saturday December 5th at 19H30.

8. DISCLAIMER

The Organizing Authority shall require each competitor to sign a waiver for loss, damage or injury to persons or property occurring in conjunction with the regatta or on the property at Clube Naval de Cascais. The Organizing Authority, the Hosting Fleet, Clube Naval de Cascais, the Event Manager and their members, employees, officers and/or agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any boat or person.
