NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES — The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The regatta is designated Category A.

2 ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY —

2.1 - The regatta is open to current members of the ISCYRA.

2.2 - The entry fee is \$59 payable to the Western Lake Michigan Star Fleet(WLM Star Fleet) and includes trophies, cookout on Saturday, and beer.

3 SCHEDULE

*no race will start after 1330 hrs on Sunday.

3.1 - Five (^) races are scheduled and one (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

4 ALTERATIONS TO THE RRS — (this list may not be complete)

4.1 - Race Signal AP will be changed so that, when made ashore, it means; "The race is postponed. The warning signal will be made not less than One (1) hour after AP is lowered."

4.2 - Appendix A 4.1 will be changed so that a boat starting later than ten (10) minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.

4.3 - Race Signal S will be changed so that when the course is shortened at a gate, an RC boat near the gate will display flag S, accompanied by two (2) sound signals, and boats shall finish by sailing through the gate from the direction of the previous mark. The finishing line will be between the gate marks.

4.4 - RRS 35 and Appendix A4.1 will be changed so that —

a) the time limit will be two and one-half (2 1/2) hours. Boats failing to finish within thirty (30) minutes after the first boat finishes or within the time limit, whichever is later, will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF).

b) When the first boat has not completed the first leg within forty-five (45) minutes after the start, the race will be abandoned.

4.5 - Appendix A will be changed so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS — will be available at registration.

6 COURSES — available at registration

7 SCORING — The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. Five (5) races are scheduled, of which one (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

8 PRIZES — will be awarded to the Skipper and Crew of the top three finishers in the regatta.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY — Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority and the host yacht club and fleet will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
