NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing(RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association(ISCYRA), as may be modified by this Notice of Race, sailing instructions, and subsequent amendments. The Organizing Authority is Cedar Point Yacht Club. The host fleet is Central Long Island Sound Star Fleet (CLIS) .

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY:

Entries must be submitted on the Official Entry Form at registration on Saturday September 7, 2018.

3. ENTRY FEE:

The entry fee of \$100 includes boat & trailer parking, launching, hauling & invitations to social events for skipper & crew, including morning coffee and donuts on the 7th & 8th and dinner Saturday evening on the upper deck of Cedar Point Yacht Club. Additional invitations to the Saturday dinner will be available at a cost of \$25.00 per person at registration.

The entry fee is due at registration on September 7, 2019. Checks should be made to "Central Long Island Sound Fleet".

The Organizing Authority, its members, employees, governors and/or agents and CLIS shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any boat.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

9. RACING AREA:

The racing area will be Long Island Sound approximately 1-3 miles southeast of the mouth of the Saugatuck River.

10. COURSES AND PROCEDURES:

Courses and procedures will be according to RULES OF THE ISCYRA, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

11. SCORING:

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply, except there will be no throw-out unless five races are completed. Five races are scheduled. One completed race constitutes a series.

12. PRIZES:

The Bedford Pitcher perpetual trophy will be awarded to the overall winner.

Take-home prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing 1 through 3.

13. HOUSING:

Housing with local yachtsmen will be provided if possible. Please contact Carroll McCallum by text: 203-554-4911.

DIRECTIONS TO THE CLUB (From North and South)

Connecticut Turnpike (I-95) to exit 17 (Westport). At the end of the ramp, turn right onto Route 136. Go about 1.5 miles on Route 136. Turn left on Duck Pond Road. Take your first left on Harbor Road. Follow Harbor Road to the stop sign before the one-way bridge.

Do not cross the bridge with a trailer in tow. Turn right just before bridge onto Canal Road. Go 0.25 miles to the end and turn left onto Cockeone Drive. Take your first left onto Spriteview Avenue and then the first right onto Crossway. This will take you to the club.

CPYC shares Saugatuck Island with a residential neighborhood that includes many young children, bicyclists and pedestrians so please observe the 15 mph speed limit on Saugatuck Island and obey all stop signs.
