ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

ISCYRA President Hubert Merkelbach opened the meeting and welcomed all those attending in person in Kiel as well as those joining via Zoom.

President's Report; Hubert welcomed everyone to the meeting and commented on what a pleasure it is to have a World Championship after the hiatus from the pandemic and that the 2021 event will have 83 boats competing.

Reports of officers:

Europe

Vice President-Tom Lofsted reported that the 2022 Worlds will be in Marblehead, MA and the Europeans are scheduled in July with ample time to ship boats. The Eastern Hemisphere will be held the end of April/early May in Naples. The 2023 calendar is being scheduled around the Worlds which will be held in Scarlino, ITA in September of 2023.

Western Hemisphere

Vice President – Paul Cayard - audio failed, but Tom Londrigan stepped in to report that the IGC is proud of the 2021 Worlds being held in Kiel, Germany and that the 100th anniversary of the Star Worlds will be celebrated in Marblehead, MA, which was a wise decision to move this event. 2023 is scheduled for Scarlino, ITA and 2024 and 2025 have not been decided, but bids have been received or intent given for San Diego in 2024 and possibly Buenos Aires in 2025. Tom outlined the 2022 North American schedule which is well coordinated for people who want to race leading up to the Worlds.

Ratification & Revocation of Fleet charters: The list of fleets who had not made the minimum boats was posted on August 26 on the website. The IGC/CMC encourages all fleet officers to ensure that all members register as members annually.
