The 2018 edition of the annual Lorain One-Design Regatta, and the Star 4th District Green Star Championships got off to a tough start with light winds on Saturday that finally built to enough velocity, after a two hour delay. A thermal finally developed from the Northwest, before veering to the North. That allowed the Star fleet to complete four races in about 6 to 8 knots of breeze.

The racing was very close on Saturday, with each of the four races being won by a different boat.

Saturday evening, everyone was treated to a very delicious Sea Food Broil, prepared by the very talented LSYC husband and wife cooking team of Don and Claudia Kasper, and their helpers.

On Sunday morning, the wind was just a little stronger than Saturday at 8 to 10 knots, and was generally from the NE, but oscillating about 30 degrees, and slowly backing to the North. Two double lap races were completed, for a total of six races for the two days.

The team of Greg Smith/T.C. Belco, who had won the last race on Saturday, also won both races on Sunday, to capture the Full Memorial Trophy, which is awarded annually to the winner of Star fleet competition at the Lorain One-Design Regatta.

Of those eligible to compete in the Green Star Championships, the team of brothers, Jeff and John Marguard scored top honors.
