NOTICE OF REGATTA

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, will be replaced by, "If there is a conflict between the sailing instructions and the notice of race, the sailing instructions shall apply."
- 1.3 The event is a Star Class Sanctioned Red Event (STCR 23.5.7).
- 1.4 For Etchells this is an open event.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Open to Stars and Etchells.
- 2.2 Entries and entry fee must be received by 0900 Wednesday 21 October at the Annapolis Yacht Club. Entry fee for Etchells is \$120 and Stars is \$95. Entries may be accepted after 0900 21 October, but will be subject to a \$20 late fee. These fees include three dinner tickets for Etchells and two tickets for Stars, plus storage and launching at the Sailing Center. Dinner will be a buffet at the clubhouse. Extra dinner tickets are \$23. Entry may be made on line at www.race.annapolisyc.com or on standard CBYRA entry forms.

4 **MEASUREMENT** – No pre-regatta measurement or weigh in required.

5 **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** - Sailing Instructions will be available at registration. They will be posted on line at www.race.annapolisyc.org when available.

6 VENUE

- 6.1 Regatta Headquarters will be the Front Office of the Annapolis Yacht Club. Registration will be in the Annapolis Yacht Club clubhouse.
- 6.2 The center of the racing area will be approximately one mile east of the Annapolis Harbor Channel entrance, R"2".

7 **ARBITRATION** - For protests involving the rules of RRS Part 2, an arbitration meeting may be held prior to the protest hearing.

8 **SCORING** - The regatta will be scored in accordance with the low point system of RRS A2 except series scores will be the sum of all race scores.

9 **HAUL OUT** - There will be no restrictions on haul-out.

10 **PRIZES** - Prizes will be awarded to skippers and crews placing first through third. For the Star Class there will be Masters and Novice trophies.
